Protect your Medicare ID number

Medicare theft is on the rise, and it is important to protect yourself and your identity.

Here's what you need to know:



PROTECT YOUR CARD

Your Medicare number is gold! Protect it like you protect your PIN number and your social security number.



NO NEED FOR A QUOTE

You should *never* need to provide your Medicare number in order to get a quote - if an agent tells you that you do, that is a red flag, and you should not provide it.



SUSPICIOUS CALLS

If you receive a call and someone is asking you to confirm your Medicare number, hang up and call your agent or your carrier. They should be able to tell you if it was a legitimate request or not.



CALL YOUR AGENT DIRECTLY

Document any details from a suspicious call - phone number, agent name, company name, etc. It may help later on if your Medicare number is compromised.



REPORT FRAUD

Should you experience fraud, and someone enrolls you in a plan without your consent or your knowledge, call your agent. They can help you figure out what to do next and how to report the fraud.
